RE: Recent Department of Commerce Policy of Denial Announcement

To Whom It May Concern:

Teledyne Technologies Incorporated (“Teledyne”) including all domestic and international subsidiaries, has a continuing commitment and obligation to comply with U.S. export laws and regulations.

Recently, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of Industry and Security (“BIS”) announced the indictment of 11 members of a Russian military procurement network operating in the United States and Russia who are charged with illegally exporting high-tech microelectronics from the United States to Russian military and intelligence agencies. In conjunction with the unsealing of these charges, the Department of Commerce has added 165 foreign persons and companies who received, transshipped, or otherwise facilitated the export of controlled commodities by the defendants to its “Entity List” located at: http://www.bis.doc.gov/policiesandregulations/ear/744_supp4.pdf . **The entities cited on this list are now under a Policy of Denial and cannot receive any Teledyne products without approval from the Department of Commerce.**

In addition, it is important as a Teledyne Customer, Sales Representative or Distributor that you understand you cannot export, re-export or transfer any Teledyne product to a person or entity cited on any of the following U.S. Government lists:



By signing an End-Use Certificate ("EUC"), End-User Statement ("EUS") or an Export Control Compliance Letter ("ECCL") at the time of order entry you are demonstrating your awareness of this obligation and certifying compliance with the relevant laws and regulations.
